



Côte-Rôtie



Born on the slopes of Côte-Rôtie, on the *Terres blondes* soils where granite and schist meet, this wine fully expresses the singular character of its terroir. The Syrah is harvested by hand and vinified in stainless-steel tanks for around fifteen days. Aged for 18 months in oak barrels, the wine reveals controlled power, aromatic complexity and finesse, carried by notes of spice, pepper and well-integrated oak. A great wine that can be enjoyed in its youth while also offering excellent ageing potential.

Varietal	100% Syrah
Soils	Granitic bedrock and schist soils

Nose	Complex, revealing notes of spice, pepper and well-integrated oak
Palate	A fine, expressive attack with a subtle peppery note. The palate is silky, carried by round, polished tannins and controlled power, leading to a wine with excellent aromatic persistence
